Mark Colmerauer Memorial Plaque

- Reviewed a mock-up of the plaque - wording and photo
- Adrienne to get input from others
- Possible revisions - different fonts used (use same/similar font?), quote by 'Dave Matthews Band' instead of writers, punctuation changes
- Will figure out date/time of dedication

Bridge over Eighteen Mile Creek

- No new information from Logan

Bird Sanctuary

- There are asphalt millings in Glen Meadows Park that could be used as a permanent trail surface (instead of mulch)
- ACTION: Mark Mol to find out if this would be possible

Fall Tree Planting

- Considering only seven trees due to \$1000 limit before required 3 bids
- Memorial tree for bird sanctuary on separate order (we will plant the tree)
- Reviewed status of residents that had street tree questions on which the Village administration asked our Commission to follow-up

Totes / Recycling

- Size of totes an issue for some residents. After 30 days residents may switch to a smaller tote.
- Our Commission recommended smaller garbage and larger recycling totes. Adrienne questioned why Village Board approved the 65 gal recycling and 95 gal garbage totes.
- Double recycling containers on Buffalo Street between Nino's and Gear For Adventure look awful / beat-up - they should be removed / replaced
- Imagine Hamburg working on trash / recycling containers for parks
