To Whom It May Concern:

Recently, the Village of Hamburg received a Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Grant for Phase 1 of the Healthy Neighborhoods Corridor Plan. Phase 1 will include sidewalk and crosswalk improvements on Division Street, Prospect Avenue, Hawkins Avenue, Union Street and Center Street. In addition the project will include pedestrian scale lighting at school intersections and pedestrian beacon signals on Legion Drive, Union Street and Center Street.

The first step is to collect topographic and right-of way survey information for this corridor. Beginning April 27<sup>th</sup>, Wendel's survey teams will be in your neighborhood to obtain this information. The survey work will take several weeks to complete.

In the coming months the Village will provide updates on the progress of the project and opportunities for you and your neighbors to provide input to the process.
