

Weekly Trash Pick Up – General Policy

All regular trash and non-recyclables must be in clear plastic bags and **must be placed** in the green lid garbage tote with the **LID CLOSED TIGHT**. No bags will be picked up if the contents are not clearly visible. 150lb. maximum weight limit per tote: **all trash, recyclables and yard waste must be out by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day**. Collection delayed 1 day after Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day.

Recyclable items must be placed in the recycling tote with the yellow lid closed tight. These items include: large mouth snap lid plastic containers, CD cases, "clamshell" style containers, pizza boxes, metal cookware, paper, milk and juice cartons, all colors of glass.

YARD WASTE – Picked up weekly on your regular garbage day from March to October. Sm. sticks, weeds, trimmed hedges. Put in open container (60 lbs. max). **GRASS CLIPPINGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED**. Compost or mow grass into lawn.

BRUSH & TREES PARTS – Collection for this starts on the last Monday of each month. Brush up to 4" in diameter and 6' in length with **NO ROOTS**, neatly piled with large end to the road (perpendicular to the street.)

LEAF COLLECTION – Pickup starts in the fall (sometimes the DPW determines a spring pick up is necessary). Rake leaves to curb or edge of grass. **DO NOT RAKE INTO THE STREET and DO NOT BAG OR STACK THEM WITH THE BRUSH**.

LARGE TRASH COLLECTION – Picked up the 3rd full week of March, June & September on **YOUR REGULAR GARBAGE DAY**. **No Appliances**. Large furniture and residential-generated construction and demolition debris (600 lb. max). **NOTE: Any and all debris from work done by a contractor, including construction and/or tree service contractor must be removed by the contractor. THIS IS THE ONLY TIME ANY OF THE ABOVE ITEMS MAY BE PUT OUT. DURING LARGE TRASH WEEK ALL ITEMS MUST BE AT THE CURB BY 7:00 AM ON YOUR REGULAR GARBAGE DAY.**

ELECTRONICS/TIRE/CAR & HOUSEHOLD BATTERY DROP OFF - Monday following Large Trash Week at 375 Pleasant Avenue; **No appliances**; All television sets, computers, monitors or other components or other electronic equipment, tires and car & household batteries can be **DROPPED OFF AT THE DPW GARAGE, 375 PLEASANT AVENUE ONLY on Electronics Drop Off Day the Monday following Large Trash Week**. There is a fee for tires, batteries and LED television and computer monitors; See Village website www.villagehamburg.com, click *Departments* and *Public Works*.

MEDICAL WASTE – Syringes and lancets **ONLY** may be brought to the Village hall in a **SHARPS CONTAINER**. Containers available at Village Hall for a small fee.

REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE – Residents that may be under a physicians care for medical issues that may include nuclear and/or chemotherapy regiments may unknowingly generate regulated medical waste that needs to be disposed outside of our waste disposal guidelines. **PLEASE CONTACT YOUR HEALTHCARE PROVIDER FOR QUESTIONS ABOUT SPECIFIC ITEMS AND THE PROPER DISPOSAL METHOD FOR EACH.**

MOTOR OIL – Use container provided by Village per request.

PAINT · PESTICIDES · CHEMICALS – **ONLY LATEX PAINT CANS WILL** be picked up. Empty paint into sand or kitty litter and leave paint cans w/the lids off next to your regular garbage. Anti-freeze, pesticides, pool chemicals, flammable materials/liquids **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED**. Call E.C. Hazardous Waste Hotline at 858-6800 for disposal information.

MISCELLANEOUS – Good Will and other thrift stores will take clothing and usable household furnishings in working order. Return used eyeglasses to opticians.
