Totes for Trash / Recycling

Village Board and DPW would like the Environmental Commission to develop policy regarding the use of garbage totes:

- Totes are about \$90 ea.
- Fund purchase with 1 year tax, spread out over years or other method?
- Adrienne to develop draft policy, send to committee members for review and then to Marc Shuttleworth for review
- **ACTION:** waiting for Marc Shuttleworth to check w/ DPW crew to relay how trash / recycling is done now for businesses (especially at the Village Plaza)

Town Widen Clean-up – Saturday, May 4th

- Envir. Com. to help with clean-up in lieu of May meeting
- Meet at Union Street entry to municipal parking or Mason's Grille 52 back lot
- Adrienne will sign-us in at Town Hall at about 8am

Other Items Discussed

- Trolley Stop Structure Status – it is assembled and ready to be moved to its location in the Legion/Clark park; no time frame known
- Vanicek Plumbing & Heating, 504 Pleasant Ave. – Their debris pile is obtrusive to neighbors; neighbor should file a report w/ the building inspector as new regulations are in effect
- Park at Main/Buffalo – the park is still in the works; the brick wall is still to be located along the sidewalk
- Village Trees – possibly 2 dead evergreen trees and dangerous erosion issues (large void under concrete at storm discharge at) Woodview Park/Gunther Hill
- Public garbage can should be considered at Lake/Highland intersection on Fisher Pools side
